Marathon

Terrain: Arena - clay/sand footing
Level: Training; 4 Obstacles
Level: Preliminary; 4 Obstacles
Level: Intermediate; 4 Obstacles
Other: Training A-B-C, Preliminary A-B-C-D, Intermediate and Advanced A-B-C-D-E. Each obstacle may be driven twice at driver option; best performance is scored. Obstacles 1 & 2 driven in a.m. Obstacles reflagged during lunch/course walk, obstacles 3 & 4 driven in p.m..

Cones

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass, Clay/Sand
Level: Training; Clearance: 40 cm horse/pony, 35 cm VSE; Notes: May be multiple obstacle
Level: Preliminary; Clearance: 35 cm horse/pony, 30 cm VSE; Notes: May be bridge and/or multiple obstacle
Level: Intermediate; Clearance: 30 cm horse/pony, 25 cm VSE; Notes: May be bridge and/or multiple obstacle
Level: Advanced; Clearance: 20 cm; Notes: May be bridge and/or multiple obstacle
Other: Timed Competition per 950.1.5 and 959. Wheels must have been measured at safety check prior to dressage. Increased clearance of 10 cm for tandems and fours per ADS 953.

Other Information

Veterinary/Health Requirements: Negative Coggins within 1 year of show date; if out of state, health certificate within 14 days
Stabling Information: One stall required per equine entered. Stabling open 9 a.m. Friday, closes 9 p.m. Sunday. 10x10 permanent wood stalls, some initial bedding provided, bring your own additional bedding (shavings not available on grounds). No stall deposits, and stalls are

cleaned for you after departure.

Driver/Groom allowed twice around (Article 910)? Yes, Entry Requirements: Driver or grooms may compete with a second entry at the discretion of the organizer, scheduling permitted. The second entry must be in a different division or entered as H.C. and driven after the competing entry. Grooms may ride with more than one entry.
