Follow signs to the Park. *From 95 North:* Take Exit 20 @ 211 W thru Raeford. Follow signs to the Park. *From Raleigh, NC:* Route 1 south all the way to Aberdeen, NC. Take Route 211 towards Raeford. Watch for the "Carolina Horse Park" sign, then turn right on Montrose Road and follow straight 2.3 miles to the park. Approximate travel time from Raleigh is 1 hour and 40 minutes. *From Fayetteville, NC:* Take Route 401 towards Raeford. From 401 in Raeford take Route 211 towards Aberdeen & Pinehurst, NC. Watch for the "Carolina Horse Park" sign, then turn left on Montrose Road and follow straight 2.3 miles to the park.
