Terrain: Training Level, VSE Prelim, flat, grass, gravel, crossing pavement.

Level: Training; 1 Section (E); 3-5 km; 3-5 Obstacles
Level: Preliminary; 1 Section (E); 6-8 km; 5-6 Obstacles
Level: Intermediate; 1 Section (E); 7-8 km; 6-7 Obstacles

Cones

Ring/Warm-up area footing: Grass, stone dust
Level: Training; Clearance: 40 cm horse/pony, 35 cm VSE;
Level: Preliminary; Clearance: 35 cm horse/pony, 30 cm VSE;
Level: Intermediate; Clearance: 30 cm horse/pony, 25 cm VSE;
Other: Increased clearance of 10 cm for tandems and fours per ADS.
