Terrain: Quite hilly, numerous stream crossings.

Other: SMV signs required, in case of excessive heat course will be shortened.
Level: Training : 3 Sections; Distance: 9-10 km; 4-5 Obstacles
Level: Preliminary: 3 Sections; Distance: 10-12 km; 5-6 Obstacles
Level: Intermediate: 3 Sections; Distance: 11-14 km; 6 Obstacles

Veterinary/Health Requirements: Negative Coggins within: 1 year of show, must be submitted with entry.
Stabling Information: Permanent Stalls with doors.
Awards Offered: Ribbons 1-6 in each class. Overall Champion and Reserve in each division. Team Award- must sign up before competitor briefing on Thursday. Teams consist of 1 Training, 1 Preliminary, 1 Intermediate OR Intermediate/Advanced competitor.
Misc. Show info : Despite past problems, ATV's will be allowed on a LIMITED BASIS this year-all competitors MUST abide by rules outlined at check-in in order for ATV use to continue. Parking space is LIMITED and will be assigned upon arrival-no exceptions. Dogs must be leashed at all times. \$30 loose dog fine per occurrence. Must include copy of ADS card with entry. Junior drivers must wear approved helmets as per ADS rules.
