Upon your arrival, prior to parking, please check in with the Stable Manager, who will be staying on the grounds. **If you are an FEI competitor, please bring your passports to the Event Office upon arrival and pick up your bridle numbers.** If you are new to Live Oak, the stables are located on the left, 1 3/4 miles after you turn south on 110th Ave.

Please remember that initial bedding is not provided and we request you purchase your shavings from the Event. You must have a current Health Certificate, within 30 days, to enter Florida. We have a golf car vendor that will be on site to rent and service gas golf cars. FEI or National Passports are required for all FEI entries.

Please utilize the hotels that support Live Oak. These include the Ocala Hilton, our host hotel; the Courtyard Marriott, the Hampton Inn and the Days Inn.

ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Please abide by the following guidelines while at Live Oak:

1. No one is allowed on course at any time other than during the official course walk. This does not include the immediate obstacle area.
2. Driving horses is limited to designated areas around the stables. See map posted at stables.
3. Please display parking passes and arm bands at all times.
4. Manure trailers are for manure only. Trash should be put in the dumpster.
5. Please use passage along west fence line for ATV's, golf cars, etc. and the road for cars and trucks. Only licensed drivers over 18 are permitted to drive golf carts, ATV's, etc.
6. The stable gate will be closed every night at 7pm with security posted. The stable office hours are 8am to 5pm. Shavings and hay will be sold at designated times only.
7. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
8. Please pick up your stall deposits from the stable manager after your stalls are stripped. They will be deposited if they are not picked up.
9. **ONLY OFFICIAL VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE COURSE OR AROUND OBSTACLES ON MARATHON DAY. ALL VEHICLES ARE TO BE PARKED IN THE PARKING LOT.**
10. Due to limited electric in the stable area, additional electric appliances will not be allowed, i.e. water heaters, fans, extension cords, etc.
11. Event Office hours are 8am to 5pm.
12. Vehicles are not allowed in the schooling area.
13. During the Vet Check Wednesday, only owners, grooms and Competitors will be allowed in the immediate area. There will be an area designated for spectators.
14. Special needs drivers must notify the organizer in advance.
