Cones

Ring/Warm-up area footing: Grass / Sand

Level: Training; Clearance: 40 cm horse/pony, 35 cm VSE; Notes: May include multiple obstacle.

Level: Preliminary; Clearance: 35 cm horse/pony, 30 cm VSE; Notes: May include bridge and/or multiple obstacle.

Level: Intermediate; Clearance: 30 cm horse/pony, 25 cm VSE; Notes: May include bridge and/or multiple obstacle.

Level: Advanced; Clearance: 20 cm; Notes: May include bridge and/or multiple obstacle.

Other: Increased clearance of 10 cm for tandems and fours per ADS. Arena size 80 x 50 meters. Fault Competition. Cones immediately follow dressage.

Other Information

Veterinary/Health Requirements: Negative Coggins within 1 year of event date, health certificate if out of state

Stabling Information: One stall required per equine entered. Permanent stabling w/ doors: hay & shavings available for purchase on grounds or bring your own. No initial bedding provided.

Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon? (Article 910) Driver or grooms may compete with a second entry at the discretion of the organizer, scheduling permitted. The second entry must be in a different division or entered as H.C and driven after the competing entry.

Grooms may ride with more than one entry.
