Test(s): Training test 4, Preliminary 4, Intermediate 3
Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass/dirt
Other Dressage Info: All tests will be on 40 x 80 Grass court. 30 minutes before dressage safety check.

Marathon

Level: Training: 3 Sections; 10 -12K km; 5 Obstacles Up to 3 gates per obstacle
Level Preliminary: 3 sections: 10- 12km; 5-6 Obstacles Up to 4 gates per obstacle
Level Intermediate: 3 Sections; 10-14 k km; 6-7 Obstacles Up to 5 gates per obstacle
Other: Vet check during marathon, Slow moving vehicle signs, helmets required.
